1. General news

We have added some new free knitting patterns to our main web site on the Free Knitting Patterns page. These new patterns are in PDF format enabling you to print off the pattern on one or two sheets. As well as the free patterns we also have some new patterns for you to buy on the web shop. These will be offered at a reduced introductory price for a limited time, after which they will revert to the full price.

It was also suggested to us by Judy in Australia that we put the DMC codes on the DMC 80 crochet cotton to make selecting colours easier, we thought this was a very good idea and so this has now been done. If you have any ideas like this, which may prove helpful to other people using the web shop, please-mail your ideas to us.

If anyone needs help ordering from the new web shop we have added a guide of 'How to order' on our web shop. If you read down the page you will find the step-by-step ordering process complete with photos of what you should see as each screen opens as you progress through the ordering process. Most people have found this to be much simpler than the previous ordering process.

3. Non-delivery of newsletters

If you want a particular item make sure you order in plenty of time.
