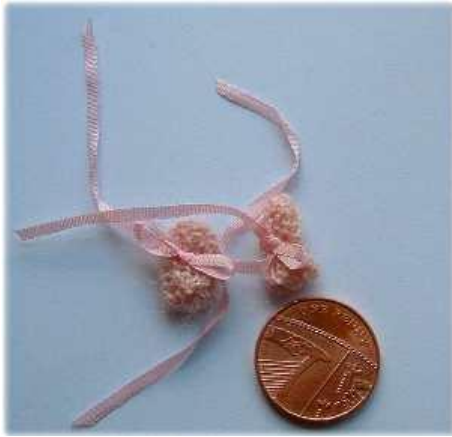


# FARTHING PATTERNS

## 1/12<sup>TH</sup> SCALE BABY MITTENS

For experienced knitters in miniature



**Materials required:** 1 pair size 19 (1 mm, US size 5/0) needles, 12 metres/yards 1-ply wool, 30 cm/12-inches long length of 2 mm silk ribbon for wrist ties.

**Abbreviations:** st - stitch; k - knit; p - purl; mst - moss stitch (k into k sts, p into p sts of previous row); yrn – yarn round needle; k2tog - knit next 2 sts together; p2tog- purl next 2 st together; sl 1, k 1, pss0 - slip next st, k1 pass slipped st over st just knitted; sl 1- slip next st; sl 1, k2tog, pss0- slip next st, k2tog pass slipped stitch over sts knitted together; rep.– repeat; ( ) – rep. instructions between brackets.

**Size:** to fit a 2-2½-inch/5 cm miniature baby doll

### Mittens (Make 2 alike)

Cast on 15 sts.

**Row 1:** mst

Change to pattern:

**Row 2:** (Wrong side facing) k 3, (p 3, k 3) to end.

**Row 3:** p 2, (k2tog, k 1, sl 1 k1 pss0, p 1) to last st, p 1.

**Row 4:** k 2, (p 3, k 1) to last st, k 1.

**Row 5:** p 1, k2tog, pick up and knit 1 stitch into thread between stitch just worked and next stitch, drop next stitch down 1 row and work k 1, yrn, k 1 into double loops. Pick up and knit 1 stitch into thread between stitch just worked and next stitch, sl 1, k2tog pss0, pick up and knit 1 stitch into thread between stitch just worked and next stitch, drop next stitch down 1 row and work k 1, yrn, k 1 into double loops. Pick up and knit 1 stitch into thread between stitch just worked and next stitch, sl 1, k1 pss0, p 1.

**Row 6:** (Decrease row) (p 2, p2tog) to last 3 sts, p 3. (12 sts)

Make eyelets for ribbon:

**Row 7:** k 1, (k2tog, yrn) to last st, k 1.

**Rows 8-12:** mst

**Row 13:** p2tog, k 1, p 1, k2tog, p2tog, k 1, p 1, k2tog. (8 sts)

**Row 14:** (k2tog, p2tog) twice. (4 sts)

Cast off.

**To make up:** Join seams. Sew in all loose ends. Thread ribbon through eyelets at top of mitten and tie in bow. (NOTE: If mittens are being placed on a doll do not cut ribbon to length until the mittens are tied on the dolls wrist, as it is very difficult to tie bows with small lengths of ribbon.)
